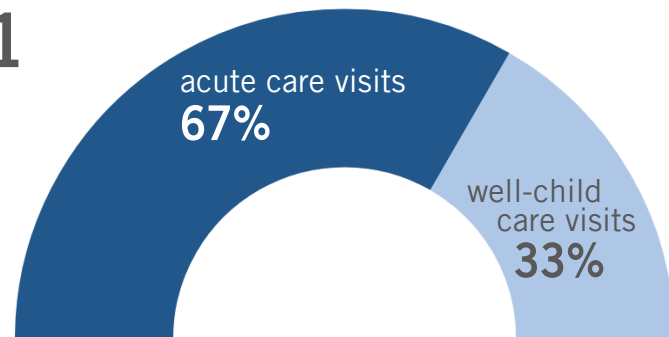
Arlington Pediatric Center (APC) opened its doors in 2001 as a community benefit program of Virginia Hospital Center and provides high quality primary, preventative, and mental healthcare services to low-income and uninsured children living in Arlington County.

Since its founding, APC has enrolled more than 13,500 children and has provided care through more than 200,000 clinical visits.

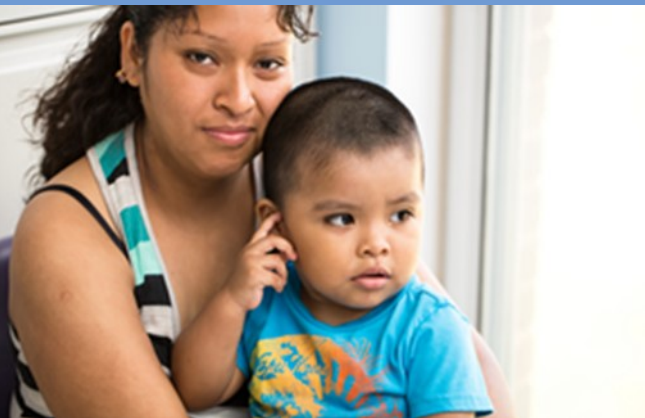
